Concurrent Schedule of Reinforcement



A schedule of reinforcement in which two or more contingencies of reinforcement operate independently and simultaneously for two or more behaviors.

Matching Law

The individual can <u>CHOOSE</u> to respond to the specific schedule as they are made simultaneously available. There are specific Sd's signaling each schedule. <u>CONC FR-50 FI-30 (min)</u>
