Multiple Schedules of Reinforcement

Definition

Presents 2+ basic schedules of reinforcement in an alternating, **usually random**, sequence. The schedules within the multiple schedule occur successively and independently.

Is the schedule
signaled by an
Sd?

YES. A discriminative stimulus is correlated with each basic schedule, and that stimulus is present as long as the schedule is in effect.

Example

FR1 FR5: When my mom is home, I get \$1 for every chore I complete. But, when my dad is home, I get \$1 for every five chores I complete.

Parents = Sd
